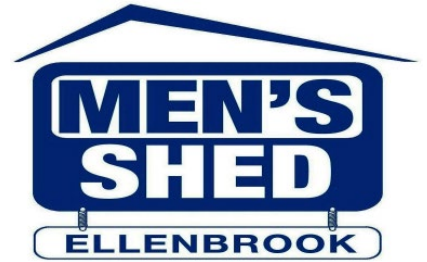

Members (with carers) are required to do an initial period of one day per week for 4 weeks. The fee as stated below is to cover this trial period. Membership is subject to meeting rules laid down in the procedure manual.

## Costs involved in Joining Ellenbrook & Districts Men's Shed.

annual fee is as specified below to cover the cost of insurance and is valid for 4 weeks only after which time a full membership is necessary.

In addition, there is a once off payment, a joining fee, as specified below. All fees stated are current and are subject to change following agreement at the Annual General Meeting, usually conducted in September of each year.

For New members, the annual membership fee is variable depending on joining date and is clearly set out in the table below. Members joining in June pay the full fee but for the following year.

In addition there is a joining fee which is fixed throughout the year.

Upon joining each new member will be issued with a name badge, and an Ellenbrook & Districts Tee Shirt, which is usually worn for external events.

Annual fees for existing members fall due 1st July and are expected to be paid before 31st July each year.

## Our Aims and Objectives

The overall aim of Ellenbrook & District Men's Shed is to provide a safe and supportive environment for males of all ages and backgrounds to gather, volunteer, work and seek fellowship with other like-minded people.

To promote the mental, physical, emotional, and economic wellbeing of males in our community.

To maintain an 'open door' policy, not rejecting any male person on the basis of ethnicity, age, disability or religion, if any.

To provide a safe physical and supportive social environment.

To offer a range of activities and programs in accordance with the interests of the Shed's members and attendees, and intended to further these aims and objectives.

To respect the rights and decisions of members and attendees, as long as they follow all guidelines, safety policies, and other procedures laid down in the Policies and Procedures Manual.

In addition, it is our aim to respect the confidentiality and privacy of members and attendees, except where life may be in direct danger or where compliance with legislation may be required.

In order to achieve these ambitious aims we expect from you the following:

## The Shed's expectations from you

That all members will actively participate in the activities of the 'Shed', contributing as much time and effort as needed/requested.

All members doing their own projects are doing them for non-commercial reasons and contribute an equal amount of time on the group activities, whether it be in making things or performing some other service. Where this is impractical the Shed is entitled to receive 50% of any commercial gain to cover the costs incurred in using the Shed's facilities, this will be in the form of a donation.

All members are expected to respect each other and their opinions at all times and under no circumstances make any remarks or make any statements or take any action, either privately or publicly that may offend, threaten, or upset another member.

All members are expected to respect the commonsense safety and cleanliness codes. Don't use a machine if you don't know how to use it, as laid down in its manual, and always ensure that if you make a mess, no matter how small, that it is cleaned up correctly using the correct materials to do so before leaving that machine or workstation. Dispose of any waste in the correct manner.

All members are expected to absent themselves if are under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

All members are to abide by the rules of the Shed, a full copy of which is available to read in the Shed.

Finally, occasionally, photographs or videos are taken in the Shed for promotional purposes, the shed expects that you give permission to use these images where necessary.
